Resolution in support of
Senate Bill S7762/ Assembly Bill A9945S
Sponsors: Senator Kaplan and Assembly Member Lavine

Whereas “All gun owners in New York should pass a background check, and all guns should be registered with a serial number. Period.” (Senator Anna Kaplan, NYSenate.Gov),

Whereas the purpose of these bills is to prohibit individuals other than a gunsmith to own an unfinished receiver for a firearm, shot gun, or rifle. Further, it establishes that the sale of unfinished receivers is a criminal offense in the first, second, or third degree,

Whereas these bills define criminal sale of an unfinished frame or receiver in the third degree as when a person other than a gunsmith sells, exchanges, or gives an unfinished receivers to anyone other than a gunsmith or voluntarily to law enforcement,

Whereas these bills define criminal sale of an unfinished frame or receiver in the second degree offense as when a person other than a gunsmith sells, exchanges, or gives 5 or more unfinished receivers to anyone other than a gunsmith or voluntarily to law enforcement,

Whereas these bills define criminal sale of an unfinished frame or receiver in the first degree offense as when a person other than a gunsmith sells, exchanges, or gives 10 or more unfinished receivers to anyone other than a gunsmith or voluntarily to law enforcement, and

Whereas these bills was named for Scott J. Beagle, a Parkland teacher who died saving students,

Therefore be it resolved that Village Independent Democrats supports Senate Bill S7762 and Assembly Bill A9945S and calls upon all elected representatives in the New York State Assembly to pass these bills.
